

that the stunning view of Mount Monadnock from the Altar of the Nations was unknown to the Sloane family at the time the land was purchased in 1935? It was after a cold spring day following the destructive Hurricane of 1938 that they discovered this view. They found a large pile of debris and as they climbed the horizontal trunks of the mighty pines felled by the hurricane, they looked off in the distance. It was many moments before a word was spoken. They saw no destruction. There before them lay the panorama which is now the backdrop of the Altar of the Nations.
